**PURPOSE** Noble Step Foundation (NSF) was established in 2014. The mission of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals enrolled for undergraduate study in community colleges, colleges, trade schools and universities. The NSF Scholarships principally target two and four year academic programs; however, certificate/licensing programs including but not limited to fields such as paralegal training, IT, ultrasound techs, medical records personnel and nursing are also eligible. Master degree and PHD students are also encouraged to apply.

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** is based on academic performance and leadership potential. Scholarships are awarded annually provided funds are available.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

NSF awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Personal Essay and Prompt Response. NSF pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient's school. The NSF Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity or gender. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

#### **CRITERIA**

- Applicants must be full-time undergraduate students attending an accredited college or university,
- Applicants must be majoring in a field of business, science, math, liberal arts or religious studies,

- High School Applicants must be accepted to a 2-4-year accredited college or university,
- Applicants must be US citizens.

## **TIMELINE**

- Applications are due **August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.**
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship no later than August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

## **Application Process**

### **NEW SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:**

- Completed application form,
- Copy of high school/college transcript from the institution (minimum required cumulative GPA dependent on scholarship selected),
- One academic references from a guidance counselor or teacher (Optional but recommended),
- Proof of acceptance at an academic, vocational or technical school for post-secondary studies (for high school students),
- Essay response to prompt posted on [noblestep.org/scholarships](http://noblestep.org/scholarships) for the selected scholarship.

### **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

- Award notification will be given by August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
- Applicant must provide their student ID and/or high school/college enrollment verification upon receipt of award. Failure to do so will result in automatic disqualification from the scholarship award.

**Deadline** for the application is **August 1st, 2017.** Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
